

Contents of Week 10

Topics

This will be the last week of our Ulisses course!

This week, the remaining learning materials related to Topic 10, "Ocean exploration using remote sensing and geophysics" will be presented. "Looking into the ocean with geophysics" is the subject being addressed. All learning materials associated to Topic 11 are made available. Three different subjects are discussed: "Circular economy", "Life cycle assessment" and "Project management".

One special bonus final Topic is included in this week's materials: "Ulisses – A literary and philosophical approach". The goal of this topic is to give to all participants an overview about the legendary Greek king *Ulisses* and the epic poem, *The Odyssey*. Who is Ulisses, what is the purpose of *The Odyssey* and Ithaca and its meaning are some thoughts we would like to share with you. As in the poem Ithaca, written by the Greek poet C.P. Cavafy, the Ulisses Team "Hope your road is a long one, full of adventure, full of discovery."
